St Stephen's-ABAN Chair in Public Policy

St Stephen's College, Delhi, invites applications from eminent personalities to fill the St Stephen's-ABAN Chair in Public Policy.

The Chair is intended for distinguished practitioners with a proven record of significant contribution to the formulation and/or shaping of public policy in any sector at the national, state, or local level/s.

The ideal candidate will be not less than 55 years of age and will have proven experience in conceptualising, formulating, and implementing policy and/or practice in government, corporate or industrial bodies, or non-governmental organisations.

The appointment will be for a term of two years, renewable after a review each year. An attractive monthly salary, a 5-day working week with flexible hours, two interns to assist during the working week and above all, the satisfaction of working in a conducive and encouraging academic environment involving enthusiastic students are the specific benefits.

The SSC-ABAN Chair will be expected to:

- Offer academic and capacity-building programmes in public policy from the St Stephen's Centre for Advanced Learning.
- Deliver an annual international lecture under the aegis of the St Stephen's-ABAN Chair in Public Policy.
- Engage with students, faculty, and stakeholders through seminars, workshops, and mentoring activities.
